1.	<p>The Tender Document mentions under Section 1.2.1.2 Qualifications of the team as mandatory requirement for the education research expert and for the public health research experts “Experience conducting education/public health related knowledge, attitude and practices studies in Uganda.”</p> <p>We have recently carried out a KAP study for Enabel in Rwanda and we would like to propose some of the experts who worked on that KAP study, but they don’t have experience with a KAP study in Uganda. We do have strong experts in Uganda as well, but they don’t bring in this experience with KAP studies. Our idea would thus be to couple our experts from the Rwanda KAP study with experts from Uganda to carry out this KAP study in Uganda, but this would mean that our</p>	<p>Knowledge of the local context is critical.
