1.	Under technical specification, items have recommended spare parts and recommended consumables. Are these anticipated to be included in the quote?	Yes, the recommended spare parts and consumables should be part of the costs as they fall within the costing of the particular piece of equipment.	
2.	The tender stated that all prices are DDP yet you have informed the meeting not to include taxes and duties.	The tenderer is to include in his unit and global prices any charges and taxes generally inherent to the performance of the contract, with the exception of the value-added tax. See section 5.4 of the tender document under "Elements included in the price."	
3.	Are there any Liquidated damages? If so, how much?	Yes, according to the Legal framework Royal Decree of 14 January 2013 – General Implementing Rules (GIR) Articles 44 to 51, 71 (General), 123 to 126 (Supplies).  Fines for delays (independent of penalties) apply:
